 - \Rightarrow Located in the crisis suite within the Weinberg Building of the Towson Campus.
 - ⇒ Hours: Monday-Friday, 10:00am-9:00pm; Saturday 1:00pm-5:00pm; closed Sundays. (Please consult website for the most up-to-date hours.)
 - ⇒ Individuals are evaluated by a licensed clinician. They provide referrals to appropriate levels of care. Serving all ages.
 - ⇒ Per clinic website, people receiving services here must be doing so voluntarily, be medically stable, be free from drugs or alcohol, and be able to safely wait for evaluation in an outpatient clinic setting.

 - ⇒ For 24-hour crisis intervention: Call 911 and request that a "CIT Trained Officer" respond to your call (CIT = Crisis Intervention Team). These officers have received specialized behavioral health training to assist people with mental illnesses to help them recognize symptoms and provide assistance as they respond to situations.

 - ⇒ Serving all ages
 - ⇒ Grassroots also provides a walk-in counseling service; anyone may walk in for counseling services without an appointment at any time, free of charge, and short-term follow-up is offered until the individual is connected with the appropriate resources. Please check the agency's website or call the main phone number for additional details.
 - ⇒ Substance use screenings available on a walk-in basis from 11:00am-7:00pm daily.
